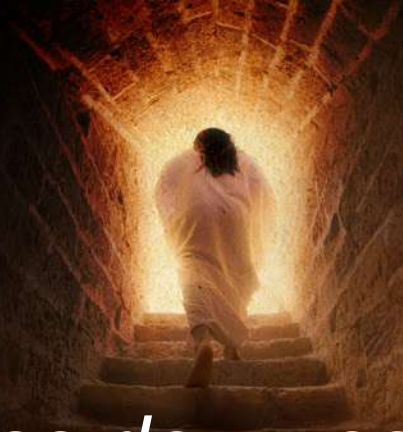
# 2. THE COMMITMENT EVENT

Simon Peter said to the others, ‘I am going fishing. We will come with you,’ they told him. So they went out in a boat, but all that night they did not catch a thing.”*

That disciple whom Jesus loved therefore said to Peter, ‘It is the Lord!’ When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on his outer garment and threw himself into the sea.” John 21:1–7*
