## NEW STUDENTS

### Application /Enrollment Fee: \$405.00

The Application Fee of \$125.00 is due and payable via the FACTS Enrollment website at the time of submitting the on-line application to be considered. This fee helps cover the cost of testing and processing the application. The Application Fee will be refunded less a \$35 testing fee if no space is available or the test was not passed.

The remaining \$280.00 balance of the Enrollment Fee is due and payable via the FACTS on-line enrollment website after the student passes the Admissions Test and must be paid to reserve a space. **The Enrollment fee is non-refundable.**

## RETURNING STUDENTS

**Re-Enrollment Fee:** \$355.00 until March 31, 2011 (\$200 due at time of re-enrollment, \$77.50 due 6/20, \$77.50 due 7/20 )  
\$405.00 after March 31, 2011 (\$200 due at time of re-enrollment, \$77.50 due 6/20, \$77.50 due 7/20 )

All returning students are to submit an on-line Re-Enrollment Application and Fee via the FACTS Enrollment website. The Re-Enrollment Fee is charged for each returning student every year and reserves a space for your child. **The Re-Enrollment fee is non-refundable.** If the Re-Enrollment Fee is not paid in full as outlined above your child(ren)'s place will be released to a child on the waiting list. We reserve a space for all currently enrolled students in good academic and behavior standing when all account balances **are current** for the school year.

## ALL STUDENTS

### Textbooks and Classroom Supplies:

All students must purchase textbooks and contribute toward the cost of classroom supplies. Book and Classroom Supply Fees listed below will be split into 2 payments and processed automatically via FACTS on 6/20/11 and 7/20/11.

### Miscellaneous Fees and Charges

Separate fees are charged for athletics (after school sports), certain electives, and other miscellaneous school activities such as field trips. Such fees are in addition to those set forth in the tuition schedule. These fees are charged as incurred.

### Before and After School Extended Care

Extended care is available for students grades K-7<sup>th</sup> before and after school, and during school breaks for an additional fee. Contact the school office for monthly contract or daily drop in rates information.

### Returned Checks (NSF)

Accounts will be charged a \$25.00 service fee for all returned checks. After two(2) returned checks, further payments must be made by cash, cashier's check, or money order.

### Missed Payment Fee

A \$25.00 missed payment fee will be assessed by FACTS for each missed EFT payment attempt. Missed payments are re-attempted approximately 15 calendar days later. A \$125.00 late fee will be assessed by North Hills once a scheduled payment exceeds 15 days past due. Accounts remaining past due are reported to a collection agency.

**A student is subject to immediate dismissal from North Hills Christian Schools if their tuition account becomes 30 days past due.**

## ***TUITION SCHEDULE 2011-2012***

Annual tuition is shown below. Does not include the application, enrollment, or book fees.

Grades 1-2	\$4,900/yr	
Grades 3-5	\$4,900/yr	
Grades 6-8	\$5,300/yr

The tuition charged by North Hills Christian Schools may be paid in one of the following ways:

- #1 Tuition is divided into **10** equal payments and paid through FACTS starting August 20, 2011.
- #2 Tuition is divided into **12** equal payments and paid through FACTS starting June 20, 2011.
- #3 Tuition is **prepaid in full** to NHCS by August 12, 2011.

### **FACTS Tuition Management**

Monthly tuition payments must be set up with FACTS via FACTS Enrollment website. Returning students' FACTS accounts will be automatically renewed each year upon receipt of Re-Enrollment application.

### **Financial Aid**

FACTS Grant Aid and Assessment Services will be used to conduct financial need assessments for families that need assistance in paying tuition. If you would like to apply for tuition assistance, you may apply online at [www.factstuitionaid.com](http://www.factstuitionaid.com) or come to the school office for an application. All applications submitted by April 30, 2011 will be reviewed on a first come, first serve basis and scholarships awarded based on recommendations from FACTS. The maximum award for a new qualified family is 50% of the annual tuition fee. Families that have received assistance in previous years will be subject to a reduced maximum; 40% if second year, 30% if third year, etc..

### **Multi-Child / Pastoral Discounts**

Multiple child discounts are available to those who have more than one child living in the same household as the responsible paying guardian. When the multiple child discount is applied, the oldest child's tuition is the full amount. The second child's tuition receives a 5% discount. The third child's tuition receives a 10% discount. The fourth child's tuition receives a 15% discount and the fifth and any additional child(ren)'s tuition receive a 20% discount. Any full-time qualified Pastor is entitled to a 25% discount in tuition. (An application is required every year to qualify for a Pastoral discount - available in finance office).

### **Referral Fee**

An existing family enrolled in North Hills can receive a referral credit against their October tuition FACTS account by referring a brand new family to enroll their children with North Hills. One credit per new family; \$100 for new K-8<sup>th</sup> students or \$150 for new 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade students, whichever is highest. Both families must have a child still in attendance on September 30, 2011 to qualify.
